On April 3, 2009, an objection to the above-referenced Annual Wage Order No. 16 was filed on behalf of Mechanical Contractors Association of Eastern Missouri, Inc. (Objector), with the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission (Commission). A prehearing in the matter had been set for April 28, 2009, and a hearing had been set for May 12, 2009.

On May 4, 2009, the Commission received a stipulation in which the Objector and the Division of Labor Standards have agreed to the wage rates which should be paid on Saturdays to the respective crafts. These wage rates are reflected in the attached stipulation.

The Commission accepts the rates reflected in the stipulation, and orders those rates to be the prevailing rates for the crafts listed therein.

STIPULATION OF FACT

Comes now the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Standards, together with the undersigned parties, and stipulates to the following facts:

1. That the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Standards gathered information to establish the Overtime Schedule for Building Construction for Annual Wage Order No. 16 in Sections 001, 004, 009, 010, 012, 014, 015, 016, 018, 021, 023, 026, 028, 033, 035, 036, 037, 040, 045, 046, 047, 050, 052, 056, 057, 058, 059, 061, 062, 063, 064, 065, 067, 068, 069, 070, 072, 075, 076, 078, 079, 081, 082, 085, 086, 087, 088, 090, 091, 092, 094, 095, 096, 100, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 109, 111, 113, 114 & 115 to be issued pursuant to Section 290.262, RSMo, and that said wage order was filed with the Secretary of State on March 10, 2009. The Overtime Schedule rate for the occupational title of Plumber and Pipe Fitter was set in accordance with information on file.

2. That the above-mentioned survey information has been maintained continuously and has been updated with additional information as it has become available, and the rates issued in the above-stated Annual Wage Order reflects the information which was available to the Division of Labor Standards at the time of issuance and filing with the Secretary of State on March 10, 2009.

3. That pursuant to Section 290.262, RSMo, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Standards, is charged with determining the prevailing rates in each locality and to do so the Department shall ascertain and consider the applicable wage rates established by collective bargaining agreements, if any, and the rates that are paid generally within a locality.


4. That after conducting its survey and with further information received (See Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof), the Department has determined that to accurately reflect the Overtime Schedule for Building Construction for Plumber and Pipe Fitter in Adair, Audrain, Bollinger, Boone, Butler, Callaway, Camden, Cape Girardeau, Carter, Chariton, Clark, Cole, Crawford, Dent, Dunklin, Franklin, Gasconade, Grundy, Howard, Howell, Iron, Jefferson, Knox, Lewis, Lincoln, Linn, Livingston, Macon, Madison, Maries, Marion, Mercer, Mississippi, Moniteau, Monroe, Montgomery, New Madrid, Oregon, Osage, Pemiscot, Perry, Phelps, Pike, Pulaski, Putnam, Ralls, Randolph, Reynolds, Ripley, St. Charles, Ste. Genevieve, St. Francois, St. Louis City, St. Louis County, Schuyler, Scotland, Scott, Shannon, Shelby, Stoddard, Sullivan, Texas, Warren, Washington and Wayne Counties Missouri the previously issued Overtime Schedule should be altered as set forth below:

OCCUPATIONAL TITLE	Plumber and Pipe Fitter	Overtime Rate	No. 91

NO. 91: Means eight (8) hours shall constitute a day's work commencing at 8:00 a.m. and ending at 4:30 p.m., allowing one-half (1/2) hour for lunch. The option exists for the Employer to use a flexible starting time between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. The regular workweek shall consist of forty (40) hours of five (5) workdays, Monday through Friday. The workweek may consist of four (4) ten (10) hour days from Monday through Thursday, with Friday as a make-up day. If the make-up day is a holiday, the employee shall be paid at the double (2) time rate. The employees shall be paid time and one-half (1 1/2) for work performed **on Saturdays**, before the regular starting time or after the regular quitting time or over eight (8) hours per work day (unless working a 10-hour work day, then time and one-half (1 1/2) is paid for work performed over ten (10) hours a day) or over forty (40) hours per work week. Work performed on Sundays and recognized holidays shall be paid at the double (2) time rate of pay.

WHEREFORE, the parties pray the Commission issue an order finding that the Overtime Schedule is as stipulated above and authorize the Division of Labor Standards to issue the attached replacement page(s) for Adair, Audrain, Bollinger, Boone, Butler, Callaway, Camden, Cape Girardeau, Carter, Chariton, Clark, Cole, Crawford, Dent, Dunklin, Franklin, Gasconade, Grundy, Howard, Howell, Iron, Jefferson, Knox, Lewis, Lincoln, Linn, Livingston, Macon, Madison, Maries, Marion, Mercer, Mississippi, Moniteau, Monroe, Montgomery, New Madrid, Oregon, Osage, Pemiscot, Perry, Phelps, Pike, Pulaski, Putnam, Ralls, Randolph, Reynolds, Ripley, St. Charles, Ste. Genevieve, St. Francois, St. Louis City, St. Louis County, Schuyler, Scotland, Scott, Shannon, Shelby, Stoddard, Sullivan, Texas, Warren, Washington and Wayne Counties setting forth the above-referenced Overtime Schedule for Plumber and Pipe Fitter.


